Planning was in place for the November Veterans Day Luncheon and other related Veterans events including the Veterans Day Ceremony at the CT Veterans Memorial West Hartford.

In October, Sr. Vice Commandeer Pat Harrell and I accompanied Commissioner Thomas Saadi, of the State Dept of Veterans Affairs along with Wayne Rioux, Veterans Liaison for Hartford Health Care, to Jerome Home in New Britain for a ceremony honoring 24 Veterans who received the CT Wartime Service Medal, miniature flags of their Branch of Service and a certificate followed by a reception provided by the Jerome Home. Pat and I performed the POW/MIA Empty Table ceremony and described what each prop represented.

November 8th Post 96 and the Elmwood Senior Center provided a luncheon for many West Hartford area Veterans. Commissioner Saadi was also the keynote speaker for this event attended by over 70 Veterans. Wayne Rioux conducted a "Generational Movement of the Flag" ceremony beginning with Fran King, WWII; Ken Hungerford, Korean Conflict; Pat Harrell, Viet Nam; Chris Bobmara, Desert Storm/OIF/OEF, Eagle Scout Helkin Sosa, Troop 163, who took position of the flag and was escorted to safety by our armed Color Guard. This ceremony was narrated by Wayne Rioux, a very impressive ceremony, indeed.

Members of the Post distributed flags to Scouts and other volunteers, at Fairview Cemetery On Saturday Nov 10th.

Veterans Day Ceremony was held at the Memorial at 1:00PM. Keynote speaker was CSM Paul Vicinus, CT Army National Guard, who kept his speech short and to the point.

Nov. 12th, members of Post 96 and Jewish War Veterans attended Conard High School for breakfast, followed by a group meeting with student and then

one on one sessions with students for questions. Then on to Hall High School, catered lunch by students in Culinary Arts course followed by a very entertaining concert.

Other members of the Post attended veterans Day events at Charter Oak Academy, King Philip Middle School, and other members to some elementary schools.

One more Veterans recognition was accomplished on Wed November 14th at Fellowship Housing on Starkel Road where Pat Harrell provided a one man performance on the Viet Nam War.

Thank you to all who volunteered for these events. More volunteers are encouraged to participate as some of the "Regulars" are unable to share their time and resources. It is a great feeling of accomplishment to "spread the word" and encouraging Americanism.

Upcoming events consist of Oratorical Contest in January, preparation for our Annual Inductee Ceremony in May, Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony in May, and School Citizenship Awards in May and June for the Middle and High Schools. Volunteers are requested to assist in these events.

As we move forward, I want to thank each and every one of you for your membership, continued support and any assistance you can provide in support of our missions.

Commander Jeffrey Cole acknowledged the dedication and professionalism of the entire West Hartford Fire Department and thanked them for all they do for the community.

Joined by over 35 of his fellow firefighters, Syme received the award at a ceremony held at the Flora Restaurant in the American Legion Building in West Hartford.

Firefighter Syme joined the West Hartford Fire Department in July of 2012, with 11 years firefighter

The Elmwood Senior Center and Hayes-Velhage Post 96 hosted its second annual luncheon for all area Veterans on Thursday, November 8, 2018 at the Elmwood Senior Center.

The event, which was attended by over 70 Veterans, had as the guest speaker Thomas J. Saadi, Commissioner, Connecticut Department of Veterans Affairs.



Commissioner Saadi, who was confirmed by the Connecticut General Assembly as Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Veterans Affairs on February 21, 2018, spoke of the focus of his Department in meeting the future needs of all Connecticut Veterans. Commissioner Saadi, acknowledging the 100th anniversary of cessation of fighting in WWI, read a letter written by a soldier in WWI to his parents before he was killed in battle. He acknowledged the sacrifice made by those who fought in WWI and that we should remember all during the 100th anniversary.

Mayor Shari Cantor and Town Manager addressed the audience thanking them for their service during the Veterans Day week.

Operation Iraqi Freedom/Operation Enduring Freedom - Commander Chris Bombara, US Navy Expeditionary Logistics Force, Jan 2004 - April 2005.

Currently Serving - Commander Chris Bombara

Eagle Scout - Helkin Sosa, Boy Scouts of America, Troop 163 West Hartford, CT, Senior student at Conard High School, West Hartford.

Eagle Scout Sosa was given responsibility for safeguarding the flag for future generations.



CSM Vicinus also told of is experiences as a soldier while serving Afghanistan as part of Operation Enduring Freedom.


