Dr. Michael Gutman Guest Speaker on Veterans Day



Retired U.S. Army Lt. Colonel and Post 96 member, Dr. Michael Gutman, was the guest speaker for the 2015 Veterans Day Ceremony at the Connecticut Veterans Memorial West Hartford.

Dr. Gutman volunteered to join the US Army reserves shortly after 9/11 and received his commission as a Major on June 4, 2002. Over the next 6 years he was deployed 3 times to combat zones, twice to Iraq and once to Bosnia. He was part of the 405th Combat Support Hospital based in West Hartford and was the commander of the 947th Forward Surgical Team for 3 years. On his first deployment to Iraq, Dr. Gutman served as the Battalion Surgeon at Abu Ghraib prison in '03-'04.

His second deployment was as Chief Medical Officer for the US contingent for the NATO forces based at Eagle Base in Tuszla, Bosnia in '05-'06, and his final deployment was in Mosul in the waning days of the Iraq war in '08-'09 where he served as Chief of the Emergency Department in the 345th Combat Support Hospital.


